One of the objectives of the Turkish Coalition of America (TCA) is to foster friendship, understanding and cooperation between the United States and Turkey. As part of this objective and to highlight Turkey's importance as a bridge between East and West, TCA in collaboration with KEI offers a study grant program to encourage African American, Hispanic American, Native American and Armenian American students to study abroad in Turkey.

Program Background

TCA will award grants in the amount of \$2,000 per semester and \$1000 per summer for full-time undergraduate and graduate students who meet eligibility requirements listed below.

Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- African American, Hispanic/Latino, Native American or Armenian American.
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents (permanent residents MUST include a copy of their green card with application)
- in good standing at an accredited university or college in the USA.
- willing to share their experience abroad with future KEI students.
- Accepted and registered for the KEI program in Istanbul, Turkey.
