

## GRIFFITH COLLEGE DUBLIN ACADEMIC TERMINOLOGY & CREDIT EQUIVALENCY

### ACADEMIC TERMINOLOGY

Griffith College curriculum is based on the Irish/British system. As such, academic terminology is different from that used in the USA. Below are some examples. This document uses the Irish academic terminology.

<u>IRISH SYSTEM</u>	→	<u>USA SYSTEM</u>
MODULE	→	COURSE
SUBJECT	→	COURSES BELONGING TO AN ACADEMIC MAJOR
COURSE	→	DEGREE PROGRAM (Ex: BA in Business)
FACULTY	→	ACADEMIC DEPARTMENT, SCHOOL OR COLLEGE

### ACADEMIC LEVEL

The academic level of undergraduate modules is indicated by the YEAR (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>) when Griffith College full-time degree students are able to enrol in the modules.

<u>IRISH SYSTEM</u>	→	<u>USA SYSTEM</u>
YEAR 1	→	BEGINNER
YEAR 2	→	INTERMEDIATE
YEAR 3	→	ADVANCED
YEAR 4	→	HONORS/PRE-GRADUTE (offered for some programs only)

### CREDIT EQUIVALENCIES

Griffith College uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). Credits (ECTS) are indicated next to the module's title.

As a general rule, 1 ECTS credit is equivalent to .5 semester credits in the USA. Credit should be rounded to the nearest whole number. For example, a module at Griffith College that is awarded 5 ECTS is equivalent to 3 semester credits in the USA. Note that 3 semester credits are the same as 4 quarter credits for students who attend universities using Quarter academic calendars. Below is a suggested equivalency table.

## **ACADEMIC OFFERINGS**

This file lists the most commonly offered modules during the Summer, Fall (semester 1) and Spring (semester 2) academic terms. However, it is possible (and likely) that some modules may be cancelled and others added. Contact a KEI Program Manager for the most updated list of modules for your academic term of study.

Typical academic load during the semester is 4 modules. Although not recommended, students may request to enrol in up to 5 modules (requires permission from KEI and Griffith College; additional fees may apply). KEI will pre-register students at Griffith College prior. However, on-site registration may be necessary upon arrival on campus.

Students should initially select (and approve for credit transfer) at least 8, preferably 10, modules. This will allow for flexibility in scheduling in case of time conflicts between modules. Griffith College does not publish the module schedule until a few days prior to the semester start date.

**Modules highlighted in blue do not require pre-approval from KEI.** All other modules require pre-approval.
